## **Expected results**

- This WP will ensure the scalability and extensibility of the product for new regions where programs for chronic disease management and diabetes prevention are currently in progress.
- The validity and range of benefits obtained from use of the novel information system will be investigated in detail through on field testing in acceding and candidate countries.

# Actions

- Partners from the above regions will be involved since the early stages of the project to share its development, in particular with the construction of the concept dictionary and web reporting tool.
- Although the partners will not directly pool own databases (there will be a development path leading to the inclusion of small databases by the end of project.
- Satellite meetings will be organized to explore perspectives of future use and extension of SEDIS beyond the member and ETA states currently involved in the project.
- Site visits will be organized regularly to ensure participation and technology transfer in the various stages of the project.
- Following the realization of the first web report, a major workshop will be organized in one of the acceding/candidate countries.
- Finally, the first official web report will include a section reporting results from extended analysis using additional databases from the acceding/candidate countries.
